Statement on PFAS (Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances)

Endress+Hauser acknowledges the global regulatory efforts to restrict PFAS due to environmental concerns. We actively monitor developments, participate in consultations, and fulfill local regulatory obligations.

We are currently assessing and classifying affected components and products. Since many purchased goods (e.g. electronic parts) may contain PFAS without clear indication, we rely on supplier data and can only make definitive statements for process-wetted parts. This information is available upon request.

We primarily use fluoropolymers such as PTFE, PFA, and FKM for their chemical stability and performance in demanding environments. These materials pose no anticipated hazard over the expected product lifetime. We do not use PFAS substances banned under current legislation (e.g. PFOA, APFO, C9–C14 PFCAs). While alternatives exist for some components, many fluorocarbon-based substances are currently irreplaceable due to their unique chemical properties. Identifying viable substitutes is a complex and long-term challenge.

Endress+Hauser is committed to sustainability and reducing critical substances. Until further notice, our products will continue to be supplied with known materials and properties. We remain dedicated to maintaining our high service standards.
